


How to improve your living environment with participation and environmental assessment

Environmental assessment


- Analyse the problem
- What environmental aspects are involved?
- Are there any opportunities or risks?



2. What can we do?

Environmental assessment

- Define the objective
- Describe possible solutions
- Specify priorities
- Are bottlenecks expected?
- Start thinking about the monitoring plan



3. Where can we do this?

Environmental assessment


- Describe the possible locations or routes
- Describe the environmental aspects involved
- Compare the different solutions



4. How do we address this?

Environmental assessment

- Are additional environmental measures needed?
- Describe information that may be an overriding factor for the implementations
- Indicate what should be included in the monitoring plan: what, how, who and with what frequency



Participation

- Recognise the problem
- Does the local community agree something needs to happen?
- Are there any opportunities or risks involved?
- Analyse interests at stake: make an inventory of interests, ideas and wishes

Participation

- Update the analysis of interests at stake
- Take this analysis into account in determining the objective
- Are there incompatible interests?

Participation

- Update the analysis of interests at stake
- Explore possible solutions with stakeholders
- Discuss the effects of the solutions with stakeholders
- Compare the different solutions with stakeholders

Participation

- Update the analysis of interests at stake
- Elaborate the chosen solution with stakeholders
- Consider a creative solution for seemingly incompatible interests
